

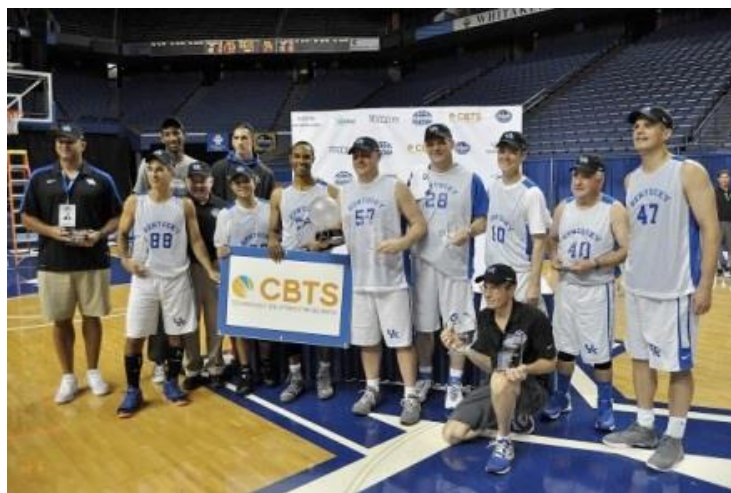
CBTS Participates in John Calipari's Fantasy Camp

CBTS sponsored one of eight teams (each team paid \$25K) at the John Calipari Fantasy Camp last weekend in Lexington. The event as a whole raised over \$1 million that went to 25 charities, including: ALS Association, Children's Home of Northern Kentucky, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, the Red Cross of the Bluegrass and others.

The camp included teams that were made up of UK coaches and players. Team CBTS was coached by new UK assistant Tony Barbee. Team managers were UK players Marcus Lee and Derrick Willis. The coaches and managers then drafted players, who came from all over the country to participate in the camp.



Former CBTS President John Burns hosted Coach Calipari and his assistants in the Pilot House on August 21 during the Reds game to choose coaches and team managers. On, August 22 the event moved to Lexington for the weekend, where teams competed against each other for three days. The final day, each team played in a tournament round at Rupp Arena.
